___ I am over the age of 18 years old

___ I understand that I shall provide adequate and human care, feeding, shelter, and protection from weather and veterinary treatment as required

___ I have spoken with the property owner or I am the property owner and I have permission to bring the animal that I adopted to that property

___ I understand that **Jackson County Animal Control** will only accept the animal back if I am a **Jackson County resident**. Should I not be able to keep the animal that I have adopted and I am not a **Jackson County resident**, I will need to contact the local rescue groups and /or the local animal control agency

___ I understand that **Jackson County Animal Control** cannot guarantee the health of the animal that I am adopting

___ I understand that **Jackson County Animal Control** does not provide refunds and /or exchanges for any reason

___ I understand that if the animal I have adopted is too young to be inoculated for rabies virus, I will be required to take the animal to a licensed veterinarian by 12 weeks of age and have the inoculation done. Also if the animal I have adopted is too young to be spayed/ neutered you will be required to take the animal to a licensed veterinarian to get it done and bring a copy back to **Jackson County Animal Control** to show that the spayed/ neutered has been done on the animal

Feline Adoption Agreement

Congratulations on your new pet! By adopting your pet, you are giving a homeless Cat a second chance at life. Remember that there are many responsibilities that come with pet ownership. Your animal friend will be totally dependent on **YOU** for the rest of its life. Be sure that you have fully considered the time, space, and financial means it takes to own a pet. Take the time to select the right pet for your needs. We will be happy to discuss any concerns you may have.

All of the cats and kittens over six months of age have tested negative for Feline Leukemia (FeLV) and Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV). Although we do try to screen animals, occasionally an adopted pet will develop an illness or problem after going home. Depending on the diagnosis and the situation, we will do our best to remedy the problem. However, no guarantees are offered in our adoption agreement. **Adoption fees are non-refundable and do not cover future illness. If family incompatibility occurs, the adoption fee WILL NOT be refunded; however, the normal fee for surrender will be waived if incompatibility occurs within ONE month of adoption.** If an adoption animal develops symptoms that you believe may be related to a preexisting condition, please contact our office. Even though there are no guarantees, we may be able to assist you with the problem at our shelter. However, we cannot be responsible for bills acquired at other veterinary hospitals.

Adoption fees are necessary to provide preventative health care for your dog as he/she enters his/her new life with you. While we do not charge a fee for the animal itself, we do require that it is spayed or neutered and that initial basic vaccines are given. These charges are significantly discounted from regular prices. Additional vaccines such as Feline Leukemia and booster shots are recommended, but are not covered in the adoption fee. A recommended booster vaccine schedule will be provided at the time of adoption. Charges for any follow up vaccinations and treatments that are due after adoption are the responsibility of the new owner and are not included in the adoption fee.

Adoption fees are to be paid in advance. The cats must be spayed or neutered before leaving the shelter. This policy follows guidelines for the National Humane Society and is designed to reduce pet overpopulation.
